How To Build A Cardboard Boat

- 1. Decide on design and sketch it. It can be any size. Let your skills and imagination go wild!
- 2. Read the Cardboard Boat Rules
- 3. Do the bottom of the boat first. Glue two to three layers of cardboard together and weigh it down. Let it set.
- 4. Cut sidepieces. Cut against the grain of the corrugated cardboard to ensure durability. Use dull side of knife when scoring the cardboard to make a fold makes it easier to bend pieces in proper shape.
- 5. Glue sides to bottom. Let glue set up.
- 6. Carefully cover any seam with duct tape.
- 7. Waterproof inside and out with any single substance compound, such as varnish.
- 8. Paint and decorate your boat.
- 9. No Flex Seal Type of Products allowed.
- 10. Go to many websites to get ideas!!!! Heber Springs CBBR or Hollywood.com.

Cardboard Boat Race Rules Construction

All boats must be built of corrugated cardboard and, if the judges deem it necessary, must pass the dreaded "Ice Pick Test" & Metal detector test!! This verifies that the boat is constructed of only cardboard. No motors. Your cardboard boat may be as thick as you want it to be. Thickness of cardboard does not matter at all. Remember, it must be all cardboard— NOT cardboard and wood or cardboard and metal or metal screws for holding. The entire boat must be built of corrugated cardboard. The only exceptions are oars or paddles. These exceptions are of course, not part of the boat proper and can be constructed of materials other than cardboard.

If you do not want your boat to sink, the Committee urges you to waterproof the entire boat with one-part substance paint. (A two-part substance would include those that require the addition of a catalyst or hardener.... This eliminates epoxy glue, fiberglass, and certain varnishes. One-part waterproofing substances are easily obtained at a paint or hardware store.) NO FLEX SEAL TYPE PRODUCTS MAY BE USED. You cannot wrap the entire boat with plastic or duct tape or any similar tape or wrap. Duct tape can only be used at the seams and stress points. However, you are allowed to reinforce all seams and stress points with tape before waterproofing.

Contestants are not allowed to use any substance, which might be harmful to the environment.

Contestants should take care to ensure that the construction of your boat does not include pointed projections and sharp edges that might cause personal injury.

No limit on how large a boat is built.
